



## Career Scholarship

The Mother's Club of Geneva is a philanthropic women's organization serving our local community for over 70 years. Through volunteerism and effective fundraising we have provided leadership opportunities and lasting friendships for our members.

The Club is pleased to offer scholarship aid to Geneva school district residents. The purpose of this scholarship is to support those students pursuing a higher education. Scholarships are offered by the Mother's Club of Geneva to qualifying applicants on the basis of financial need, community service and academic achievement. For the academic year 2010-2011, we are able to award twelve \$ 1,000 scholarships.

### I. Eligibility:

1. Scholarship applicants must be a:
  - a. Geneva School District resident *and*
  - b. High School senior, current college student or adult returning to college for the 2010-2011 academic year
2. Applicant must enroll in a school at an accredited two or four-year college or university or vocational-technical school
3. Must have a minimum grade point average of 2.5

### II. Application Process:

1. Application forms are available at the Geneva High School guidance office, the Geneva Public Library or can be downloaded from the Mother's Club of Geneva website at [www.mothersclubofgeneva.com](http://www.mothersclubofgeneva.com).
2. A scholarship selection committee will confidentially review all applicants. ALL INFORMATION WILL BE HELD IN STRICT CONFIDENCE.
3. Applications along with required attachments must be postmarked March 31, 2010.
4. Final selection of the candidates may include an interview.
5. The scholarship checks will be made payable to the school for the student.
6. Notification of scholarship recipients will be by May 7, 2010.
